

Appeals Committee

Medical students have the right to appeal a negative promotion decision. They must submit the appeal in writing to the Carver College of Medicine's Executive Dean within five days of notification of the decision.

Appeals are considered by the Appeals Committee, made up of faculty representatives from the Medical Council and the Executive Committee, a medical student and a lay member. The Associate Dean for Student Affairs is ex officio. Students may request an opportunity to appear before the Appeals Committee to make a statement and answer questions.

The student member is appointed by the Associate Dean for Student Affairs and must be in good academic standing.

The committee makes its recommendation to the college's Dean, who is the final authority.
