Dear Dr. Wilson:

After review of the requested interim report, the continuing accreditation status of the baccalaureate degree radiography program sponsored by the University of Iowa was considered at the April 21, 2022 meeting of the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT). The JRCERT is the only agency recognized by the United States Department of Education (USDE) and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) for the accreditation of traditional and distance delivery educational programs in radiography, radiation therapy, magnetic resonance, and medical dosimetry. Specialized accreditation awarded by the JRCERT offers institutions significant value by providing peer evaluation and by assuring the public of quality professional education in the radiologic sciences. The program was evaluated according to the **Standards for an Accredited Educational Program in Radiography (2021)**. The program documents compliance with all relevant Standards; therefore, the JRCERT awards:

**MAINTENANCE OF ACCREDITATION FOR A PERIOD OF EIGHT YEARS.**

The next site visit is tentatively scheduled for the First Quarter of 2026.

The program is advised to thoroughly analyze all student learning outcome data annually and maintain documentation that data and analysis is shared with the program's communities of interest.

Consistent with JRCERT Policy 11.500, the JRCERT has determined that program officials would benefit from a JRCERT-sponsored Outcomes Assessment Workshop. Program officials may elect to substitute workshop attendance by completing the corresponding approved JRCERT Link Courses (e-learning). It is noted that the program director has completed the Outcomes Assessment e-learning Module. The program is advised that the 2021 Standards Course will also need to be completed for substitution of an in-person workshop. Therefore, a progress report documenting the program director's attendance at an Outcomes Assessment Workshop or completion of the approved e-learning substitution must be submitted no later than **April 21, 2023**.
